

AUTUMN CORN WINDSOCKS

This craft uses
bubble wrap to
create the 'corn'
effect

You will need:

- A4 yellow card sheet
- Green paper
- Green tissue paper
- Brown paint
- Piece of bubble wrap
- Ribbon or string

Other things you'll need:

- Glue or sticky tape
- Scissors
- Hole punch
- Paint tray or dish

How to make it:

- 1 Start by putting some brown paint into a painting dish or tray. Dip a piece of bubble wrap into the paint and dab it over the sheet of yellow card to print the effect of corn kernels. Then set aside to dry.
- 2 While the painted sheet is drying, cut 5 or 6 leaf shapes from green paper. A template is provided on page 2.
- 3 Take the dried sheet of yellow paper and roll up widthways to make a cylinder, roughly 7cm diameter. Secure with sticky tape. Then gently flatten one end of the cylinder and use scissors to cut a pointed end.
- 4 Glue the green paper leaves all around the paper roll at the uncut end.
- 5 While the glue is drying, cut strips from green tissue paper. These will make the windsock's streamers. Glue the strips inside the windsock so that they hang down below the green paper leaves.
- 6 Use a hole punch to make a hole in the pointed end of the windsock. Punch the hole through both sides. Then tie on some ribbon or string for hanging.
- 7 Finish the windsock by bending the leaves down a little to make them look a little more realistic. Then hang the windsock up outdoors and watch the streamers fly!

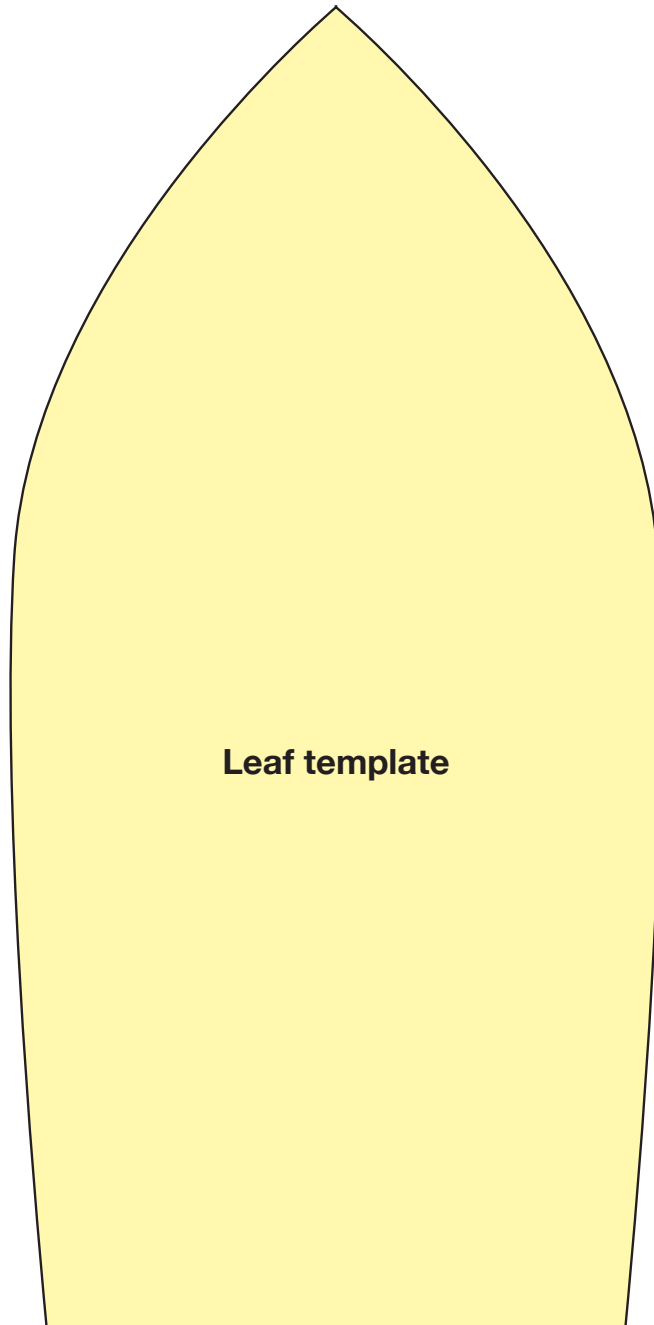
