

AUTUMN WREATH

A fun-to-make decoration for the autumn season.



You will need:

- Paper plate
- Polyester artificial leaves
- Ribbon for hanging

Other things you'll need:

- Glue gun
- Scissors
- Stapler or sticky tape

**Why not add to this basic wreath with fallen autumn leaves, conkers and other nature finds?
Ask an adult to help you find suitable natural objects.**

How to make it:

- 1 Start by cutting out the centre of the paper plate with scissors. This gives you the circular wreath shape onto which you can glue your leaves.
- 2 Use a hot glue gun (adult supervision required!) to glue artificial leaves onto the paper plate wreath. Pay attention to shapes and colours to create a balanced effect. Leave to dry.
- 3 Cut a length of ribbon and attach it to the back of the wreath using sticky tape or a stapler.
- 4 Hang your wreath on a wall or the back of a door, or as part of an autumn display.

IDEA: Make a double-sided wreath by gluing leaves onto both sides and hang it somewhere both sides can be seen.
