## 1 EASY-TO-MAKE... LITTLE CHICK EASTER PURSE

Collect your Easter eggs in style with this cute purse!

## You will need:

- Paper plate
- Yellow paint
- Orange card
- Coloured feathers
- Length of cord or yarn
- Wiggle eyes (optional)

## Other things you'll need:

- Glue and scissors
- Black pen or felt-tip
- Hole punch
- Sticky tape

## How to make it:

- Turn the paper plate upside down and paint it in bright yellow paint. Set aside to dry.
- While the paint is drying, cut two strips from orange card approximately 2cm wide and 15cm long. Then use the template below to cut two foot shapes from orange card.
- 3 Fold the orange strips in a concertina style. Glue a foot to the end of each strip.
- 4 Once the paint has dried, cut the paper plate in half to make two semi-circles. Place one half on the table in front of you, painted side down. Position the two orange legs over the curved edge (see image) and then glue the second half on top, painted side out. You can secure the legs with sticky tape before sandwiching the two halves together if this is easier.
- 5 Decorate the purse with feathers for wings and a diamond shaped piece of card folded in half for a beak. Draw on eyes with a black pen or glue on wiggle eyes if using.
- 6 When the glue has dried punch a hole at each end of the purse's straight edge. To finish, tie on a length of cord or yarn to create the purse's shoulder strap.
