2 EASY-TO-MAKE... HONEY BEE PEN TOPPERS

Fun to make honey bees to adorn your pens and pencils

You will need:

- 1 x yellow pipecleaner
- 1 x black pipecleaner
- 1 x white pipecleaner
- 2 x small wiggle eyes
- Piece of tracing paper or pre-cut heart shape
- Piece of coloured paper or pre-cut flower shape
- Small circle of yellow paper

Other things you'll need:

- Glue and scissors
- Pencil

How to make it:

- Take a black pipecleaner and wind it around a pencil. Then wind the yellow pipecleaner around the pencil, in between the black coils you have just made. Remove from the pencil and tuck the ends in to make them tidy. If needed, squash the coils up a bit to make them tighter.
- 2 Now take the white pipecleaner and wind half around the pencil leaving half straight. Bend the end (A) back on itself a little to make it easier to attach to the bee.



- Add some glue to the white pipecleaner at point **A**. Push the white pipecleaner (point **A**) into the bee between the coils and set aside to dry.
- 4 Carefully stick two small wiggle eyes to the bee.
- 5 Cut out a heart shape from tracing paper. Cut out the flower shape and small circle from coloured paper. Add a little glue to the point of the heart shape and push it between the coils at the top of the bee.
- 6 Glue the small circle to the flower shape. Glue the flower to the white pipecleaner, below the bee, and set aside to dry.
- 7 When the glue is dry, thread the coiled end of the white pipecleaner to your favourite pen or pencil.
