EASY-TO-MAKE...

RECYCLED DECORATIONS

A decorative way to use up scrap card or old book covers



You will need:

- Coloured scrap card – we used recycled exercise book covers
- A length of yarn to hang the decorations

Other things you'll need:

- Glue or double-sided tape
- Scissors

How to make it:

- 1 Take your sheets of card or exercise book covers and make sure they're all roughly the same size. Trim if necessary.
- 2 Roll the sheets of card into tube shapes and glue or use double-side tape to secure in place. Allow the glue to dry before moving onto the next stage.
- 3 Cut the tubes into individual rings of roughly the same width. It doesn't matter if you squash the tubes in the process as this creates the pointed 'leaf' shape you'll need to make the decoration.
- 4 Arrange the rings on the table in front of you. Alternate the colours and build a star shape using about 10 rings. When you're happy with the design, use glue or double-sided tape to stick the rings together as shown in the diagram.
- 5 When the glue is dry, tie on a length of yarn and hang the decoration up!
