

# HANGING DREIDEL BOXES

A dreidel is a four sided spinning top, traditionally played during the Jewish holiday of Hanukkah



## You will need:

- Coloured card or paper
- Standard size lolly sticks
- Ribbons
- Coloured stars or stickers

## Other things you'll need:

- Glue and sticky tape
- Scissors
- Pencil and ruler
- Craft knife (optional)

## How to make it:

- 1 Start by tracing or drawing the template provided on page 2 onto some coloured card or paper. You could also print the template page onto some coloured paper.
- 2 Cut the template out. Then use some scissors and a ruler to carefully score along the dotted lines. This will make it easier to fold the dreidel shape. Fold along the lines you have just scored.
- 3 Cut a slot along the line marked **A**. You can do this with scissors but it's easier to do with a ruler and craft knife.
- 4 Next, put a little glue onto the tabs marked **B**. Fold up the dreidel box and use the tabs to secure in place. Then add some glue to the tabs marked **C** and secure in place.
- 5 Once the glue is dry, push a lolly stick into the slot **A**. This makes the handle of the dreidel. You might need to use some sticky tape to secure the stick in place.
- 6 Decorate the dreidel boxes with coloured stars or stickers.
- 7 Finish by tying some coloured ribbon to the lolly stick to enable you to hang the dreidel up as a decoration at Hanukkah.
