FASY-TO-MAKE PAPER PLATE FLAMINGO





You will need:

- Paper plate
- Wiggly eye
- Pink paint
- Feathers
- A4 pink card

Other things you'll need:

- Glue
- Scissors
- Black marker
- Pencil

How to make it:

- To begin, draw the outline of the flamingo on the paper plate. Use the diagram opposite as a guide. Cut the shape out with scissors.
- 2 Paint the plate with pink paint. Leave a patch white to make the flamingo's beak. Leave to dry.
- 3 Cut two strips approximately 21cm long x 2.5cm wide from a piece of pink card. Concertina fold the strips, then glue them in place on the back of the paper plate. Finish by making two or three cuts in the ends of the strips to make the flamingo's feet.
- 4 Glue a wiggly eye in place on the flamingo's face.
- 5 Use a black marker to draw in the detail of the flamingo's beak.
- 6 Finish by gluing lots of feathers to the paper plate to make the flamingo's wing.

This paper plate flamingo makes a fun wall decoration or can be used as part of a colourful tropical display.
